TO: REGISTERED LOUISIANA LOBBYISTS
RE: STATE CAPITOL IDENTIFICATION BADGES

Senate President J. Cameron Henry, Jr. and Speaker of the House Phillip DeVillier remind all registered Louisiana Lobbyists to renew their state capitol identification badges ahead of the 2025 Legislative Session.

While lobbyists are not required to have an identification badge to communicate or lobby the legislature, a 2025 badge assists the Capitol Security Office in confirming your identity and can expedite your entrance into the building including compliance with routine security measures. The legislature reserves the right to search any person entering the State Capitol Complex.

To qualify for a Lobbyist Identification Badge applicants must:

1. Register with the Louisiana Board of Ethics and maintain "active" status including a valid LB number (used to access the Lobbyist Online System)
2. Fill out Lobbyist Individual or Group Badge Application online at https://house.louisiana.gov/H_Staff/H_Staff_Sergeant and include a JPEG photo/headshot
3. Pay the annual \$10 registration fee via check or money order made out to House of Representatives (NO CASH or CREDIT CARDS)

Once approved, your identification badge will be printed and available for pick up in Room 207 of the Capitol Security Office located on the 2nd floor of the Louisiana State Capitol.
