Defendants United States and Eric Holder, in his official capacity as the Attorney General of the United States (“Attorney General”), in the above-styled case, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b)(1), hereby move this Court for dismissal of the above-styled action for lack of jurisdiction. As discussed in the attached brief, this declaratory judgment action is moot in light of the Attorney General’s administrative preclearance of the voting change at issue in this litigation, Louisiana House Bill 1, the 2011 Louisiana House redistricting plan, under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act, 42 U.S.C. 1973c, and should therefore be dismissed. Counsel for Defendants has spoken with counsel for Plaintiff who advises that Plaintiff does not oppose this motion to dismiss.
