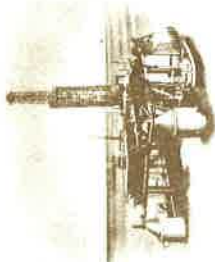
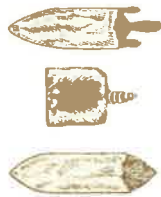

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, state lawmakers will meet in special session in March, 2011 to redraw Louisiana's representative districts; and

WHEREAS, projections are that the 2010 Census will show significant population shifts as a result of Hurricanes Katrina, Rita, Gustav and Ike; and

WHEREAS, both Cameron Parish and Vermilion Parish have been affected by significant population shifts as a result of these hurricanes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that during the redistricting process consideration be given to allow Cameron Parish to remain in District 47, represented by Representative Jonathan Perry.
