On a joint motion of the Council with unanimous consent, it was moved to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION SBPC #644-06-10

A RESOLUTION TO LOUISIANA STATE OFFICIALS STATING ST. BERNARD'S POSITION ON REDISTRICTING OF THE HOUSE AND SENATE SEATS.

WHEREAS, this resolution is in regards to the upcoming redistricting of the House and Senate seats in the State of Louisiana, and;

WHEREAS, our main concern is that St. Bernard Parish will be divided up in the House of Representatives, and;

WHEREAS, it is critical to our continued recovery that we have one person in Baton Rouge speaking for the needs of St. Bernard Parish, and;

WHEREAS, St. Bernard and Plaquemines Parishes are two of the most vulnerable Parishes for Gulf related catastrophes, and we would further like to request we be placed in the same Senatorial District, and;

WHEREAS, we would like to see a Coastal District for Senate 1, as it used to be, so that common goals can be addressed along with surrounding parishes that border the Gulf.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the St. Bernard Parish Council, the Governing Authority, does hereby strongly urge Honorable Louisiana State Officials that St. Bernard Parish be left contiguous in any redistricting of House and Senate Seats that will affect St. Bernard Parish.


The Council Chair, Mr. Landry, cast his vote as **YEA**.
