- **\$900 Billion in Total Coronavirus Relief Funding**
- **Major Areas of Funding:**
 - **Education - \$91 Billion**
 - Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund - \$54.3 Billion
 - Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund - \$4.1 Billion
 - Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund - \$22.7 Billion
 - Early Childhood Education - \$10 Billion
 - **Healthcare - \$62.6 Billion**
 - COVID Testing, Vaccines, & Research- \$58.3 Billion
 - Mental Health - \$4.25 Billion
 - **Small Business Aid - \$325 Billion**
 - Payment Protection Program 2 - \$284 Billion
 - Shuttered Venue Assistance - \$15 Billion
 - **Transportation - \$45 Billion**
 - **Agriculture - \$12 Billion**
 - **Rental Assistance - \$25 Billion**
 - **Broadband - \$7 Billion**
 - **Food Assistance/SNAP Benefits- \$500M plus expanded SNAP eligibility**
 - **Unemployment - \$120 Billion**
 - **USPS - \$10 Billion**
 - **Stimulus Checks - \$600 for individuals making up to \$75,000, \$1,200 for couple making up to \$150,000, and \$600 for dependents under 17 years old**
