

- The ENCORE! Program encourages retirees to locate to Louisiana.


Grants

The Lt. Governor's Office Grants Program administers the following:

- The AmeriCorps Grants program addresses critical needs in education, economic opportunity, environmental stewardship, healthy futures, disaster services, and veterans and military families. Volunteer Louisiana supports 17 AmeriCorps programs that engage 1,000 AmeriCorps members in service each year.
- <u>VolunteerLouisiana.gov</u> works to increase volunteerism by connecting volunteers with volunteer organizations statewide. Volunteer Louisiana supports numerous volunteer recognition initiatives and is charged in the state's emergency operation plan with the rapid and efficient coordination of volunteers preparing for and responding to a disaster.

MAJOR SOURCES OF REVENUE

Federal Funds \$5.5 Million

Funding comes from the Corporation for National and Community Service, which allows Volunteer Louisiana to oversee the AmeriCorps State service programs. These are three-year grants that are renewed upon expiration.

Interagency Transfers \$672,296

These funds are transferred by the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism to the Office of Lieutenant Governor for administration. Self Generated \$10,000

This budget authority is for donations from outside organizations.



FY 19 EXPENDITURE TREND



Analysis shows approximately \$278,028 or 4% in total means of finance budget authority (\$7.2M budgeted - \$6.9M projected) could be unspent at yearend based on actuals through February and projections through the end of the year.

In FY 18, the Department did not spend \$607,225 or 8.4% of its budget authority comparing its end of year budget and actual expenditures. \$607,225 is compromised of \$23,000 in SGF, \$108,231 IAT, \$10,000 in FSGR, and \$465,994 in FED.

The Office of the Lt. Governor did not revert any money into FY 19.



VOLUNTEER LOUISIANA SERVICE MAP


